¿Qué es un ITIN? / What is an ITIN?

El ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification Number) es un número emitido por el IRS para personas que necesitan cumplir con obligaciones fiscales en EE.UU. pero no califican para un SSN.

An ITIN is a tax processing number issued by the IRS for individuals who are required to file U.S. taxes but are not eligible for a Social Security Number.

¿Quién necesita un ITIN? / Who needs an ITIN?

Personas sin estatus migratorio, extranjeros no residentes, dependientes o cónyuges.

Non-residents, undocumented individuals, spouses or dependents.

¿Para qué sirve un ITIN? / What is an ITIN used for?

Declarar impuestos, abrir cuentas financieras, cumplir con obligaciones fiscales.

To file taxes, comply with IRS requirements, and in some cases open financial accounts.

Requisitos / Requirements

Formulario W-7, identificación válida, declaración de impuestos (cuando aplique).

Form W-7, valid identification, tax return when required.

Importante / Important

Un ITIN no autoriza trabajo ni cambia estatus migratorio.

An ITIN does not authorize work or change immigration status.
